## **SUBMISSION OF LEICESTERSHIRE MINERALS AND WASTE LOCAL PLAN**

In July 2016 the County Council published and invited comments on the Pre-Submission Draft Minerals and Waste Local Plan for Leicestershire. The representations that were received prompted a number of Proposed Changes to the document, which were then published for consultation in November 2017.

The County Council has now submitted the Leicestershire Minerals and Waste Local Plan (incorporating the Proposed Changes), together with all the representations received from both consultation exercises and relevant supporting documents, to the Secretary of State for independent examination.

Stephen Normington BSc DipTP MRICS MRTPI FIQ FIHE.


