IN12: Provisional hearings programme and lists of participants

The examination hearing sessions are currently expected to commence on 1 November 2022. They will take place at the former Manchester Fire and Rescue Training Centre, Cassidy Close, Manchester M4 5HU.

On 6 June 2022, we published a note inviting representors to inform the Programme Officers if they wished to participate in the hearing sessions¹. Nearly 200 individuals and organisations responded by the deadline of 27 June to state that they wished to participate at one or more hearing session.

Between 5 and 21 July we published four notes setting out the matters, issues and questions that will be the focus of our examination of the Plan and invited written statements in response with deadlines by which they must be received by the Programme Officers².

The Annex attached to this note is a provisional programme setting out when we currently expect to discuss each of our matters and issues at a hearing session, along with draft lists of participants for each session.

The Programme Officers received requests from around 100 different individuals and organisations to participate in the hearing sessions for some matters and issues. However, to allow us to thoroughly consider each issue, and those participating to effectively contribute, a maximum of around 25 participants will normally be able to attend each session. This is in accordance with established good practice for local plan examination hearings, based on past experience³. Exceptionally, we will accommodate more than 25 participants at a session if we consider it would expedite the examination process. Each participant at every session will normally have one seat at the table (with

the exception of GMCA who will have up to four). A limited amount of "hot seating" will be allowed within a session if a participant considers it essential that a different person acts for them in relation to a particular issue, although this must be kept to a minimum to avoid disruption to proceedings.

As advised in our earlier note, no representor has a right to participate at more than one hearing session. Whilst we have sought to accommodate the requests made to the Programme Officers as far as possible, not every individual and organisation will be able to participate in every issue that they have expressed an interest in. The draft lists in the Annex ensure that every representor who responded to the Programme Officers will be able to participate for at least one issue, and in most cases for many if not all of the issues that they expressed an interest in. We have compiled the draft lists having regard to the following:

- Relevance of representation made under regulation 20 to our specific issues and questions.
- Achieving fairness in the exercise of the right to be heard.
- Assisting us in considering the examination matters and issues by hearing from economic, environmental and social perspectives and a range of individuals, organisations and companies.

In some cases we have listed a consultant / agent as the participant, rather than the representor(s) they are acting for. In those cases, the consultant / agent will need to agree with their client(s) who they are participating on behalf of, and this can vary for different sessions. The consultant / agent should clarify before or at each hearing session the representor(s) they are participating on behalf of. This approach is necessary to keep numbers manageable and avoid unnecessary duplication, and in the interest of seeking a balanced input from developer and other perspectives.

If any participant listed in the Annex considers it essential that they participate for an issue that they are not currently allocated to, they should contact the Programme Officers in writing by **midday on Thursday 8 September 2022**. Any such requests must briefly state why they consider it essential for them to participate in the additional issue with reference to the above three bullet points (**maximum 300 words**). However, before doing so please consider the following:

- Representors can submit written statements relating to all issues relevant to their regulation 20 representations, not only those that they are participating in.
- We will read all written statements before the relevant hearing session and take them into account in our assessment of whether the Plan is legally compliant and sound.
- Representors can liaise with participants who have similar interests to ensure relevant points are made orally if necessary by a single spokesperson.
- There is no need to make the same or similar points at more than one hearing session, or as made by another participant.
- All site specific discussions, including whether allocations are consistent with the objectives and thematic policies in the Plan, will take place in the later hearing sessions relating to allocated sites.
- All sessions will be available to view online, and there may be the opportunity to attend the venue to observe.

We will consider all requests received by the deadline before finalising the lists of participants. However, we will not respond in writing to requests made.

Finally, if any representor does **not** wish to participate in one or more of the sessions they are allocated to in the Annex please advise the Programme Officers by **midday on Thursday 8 September 2022.**
