

Examination of Places for Everyone Joint Development Plan Document

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IN8.1 Addendum to IN8 Matters, Issues and Questions relating to legal, procedural and other general matters, and the Plan's spatial strategy

IN8 was published on 5 July 2022. This addendum includes an additional Issue and Question under Matter 3, and provides clarification about the word limit for written statements.

Matter 3: Spatial strategy and methodology for selecting site allocations

Issue 3.4 Do the allocations in the Plan take appropriate account of the presence of minerals and minerals infrastructure?

- Q3.11 Do the allocations in the Plan take appropriate account of the presence of minerals and minerals infrastructure? In particular:
- a) Was the presence of minerals and minerals infrastructure adequately taken into account when deciding which sites to allocate in the Plan?
 - b) Are any of the allocations within minerals safeguarding areas designated in the adopted Greater Manchester Joint Minerals Development Plan Document or other relevant development plan document?
 - c) Are the policies relating to allocations in the Plan consistent with policies in the adopted Greater Manchester Joint Minerals Development Plan Document and any other relevant minerals and minerals infrastructure policies in other adopted development plan document?

Written statements word limit

Annex 1 to IN8 sets a limit of **3,000 words** for statements relating to each Matter. However, some of the Matters have more Issues and Questions than others. Therefore, in the interests of fairness and to ensure that Questions can be properly

answered by all representors, we will allow statements relating to Matters 1 to 5 to exceed 3,000 words in the following circumstances:

- If a representor made representations under regulation 20 relating to all or most Questions under one of our Matters.
- Responses to individual Questions do not exceed **500 words**.
- The statement is succinct, focussed on our Questions, and avoids repetition.

Written statements in response to the Questions relating to Matters 1 to 5, including Question 3.11 above, must be emailed to the Programme Officers in PDF format by **midday on Thursday 8 September 2022**.

We will set appropriate word limits for statements relating to thematic policies, allocations, and Green Belt additions in separate notes relating to those Matters.
