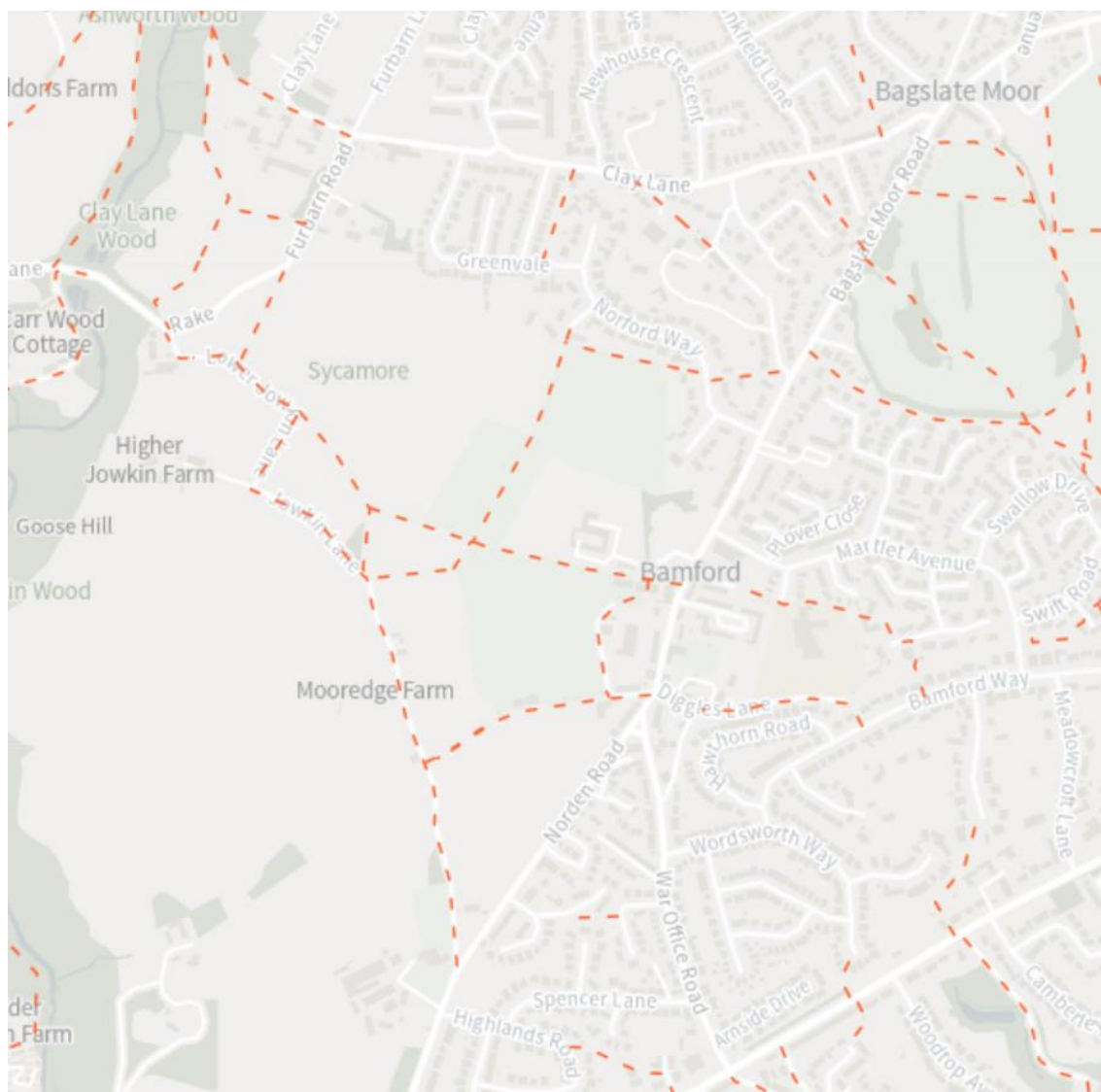


Map illustrating public rights of way on and near to the proposed allocation JPA19 – Bamford and Norden in the Places for Everyone Plan

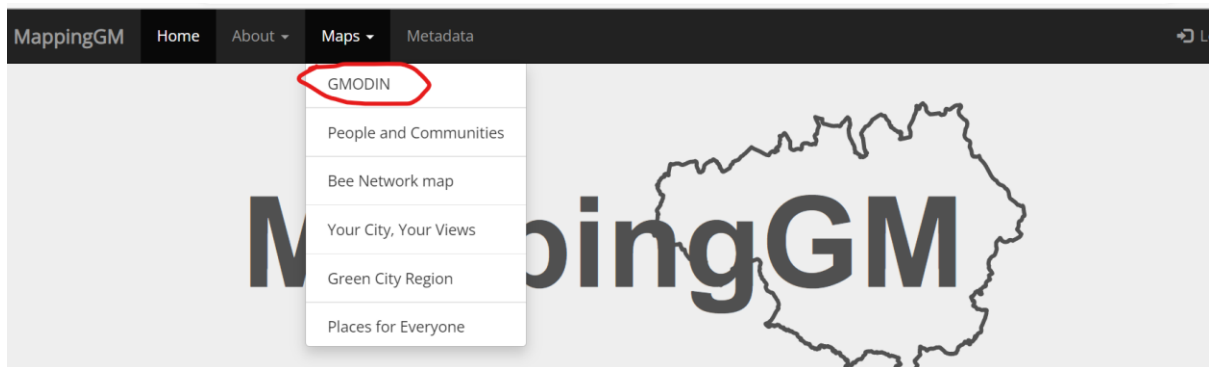
3. MappingGM provides similar data to the above for the whole of Greater Manchester. The appendix to this note provides guidance as to how this and other data can be accessed.

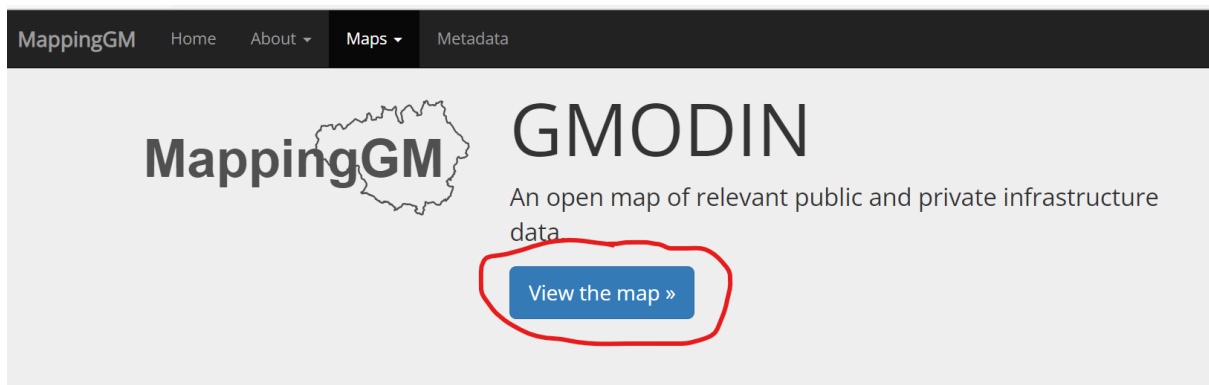
Guidance on how to access rights of way mapping on MappingGM

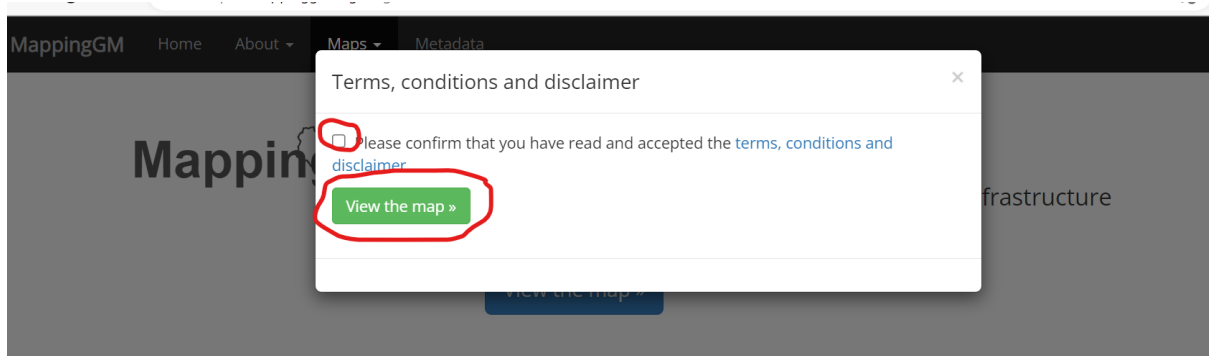
Select GMODIN:



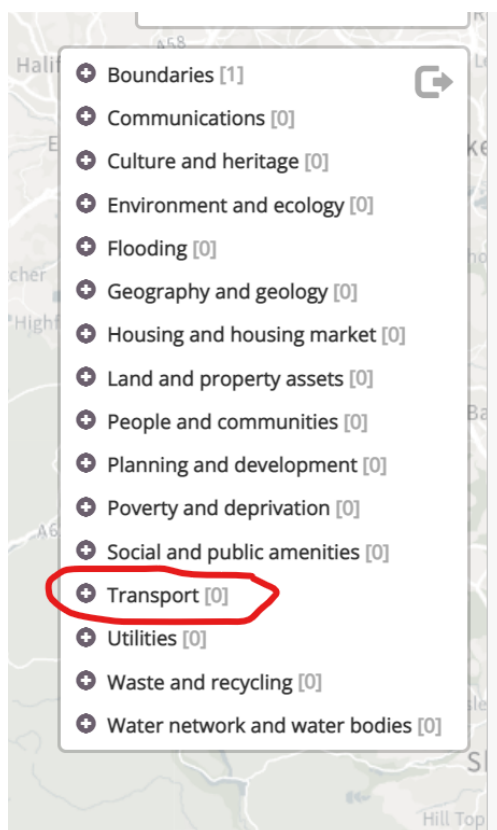
Select “View the map”



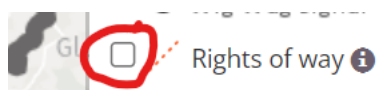
“Check” to terms and conditions’ box, then select “View the map”:
